



Counselors are here to help



As we complete our first 9 weeks together, let us review some basic reminders for success in middle school:

- 1. Stay Organized: Use a planner to keep track of assignments, tests, and activities. Organize your backpack and study space to avoid last-minute stress.
- 2. Manage Time Well: Break big projects into smaller tasks and spread them out over time. Avoid procrastination and set specific time for homework and studying.
- 3. Pay Attention in Class: Focus on the teacher, take clear notes, and ask questions if you're unsure about something. Active listening helps you understand and retain information.
- 4. Complete Homework on Time: Homework reinforces what you've learned. Prioritize completing assignments before they pile up.
- 5. **Build Good Study Habits:** Review your notes regularly and quiz yourself. Find what study methods work best for you.
- 6. Stay Positive and Persistent: It's normal to face challenges. Keep a growth mindset—the belief that effort leads to improvement and don't get discouraged by setbacks.
- 7. **Take Care of Your Health:** Get enough sleep, eat healthy, and stay active. Physical well-being supports mental focus and emotional balance.
- 8. **Ask for Help When Needed:** Don't hesitate to ask teachers, counselors, classmates, or parents for help if you're struggling.
- 9. **Develop Friendships and Social Skills:** Join clubs, sports, or activities that interest you. Building friendships and learning how to work well with others is just as important as academic success.
- 10. **Balance Work and Fun:** While school is important, make sure you also enjoy time with friends and family and pursue hobbies you love. Balance is key.




